Course Fee Structure

•For Bangladeshi students

Total course fee: **BDT 9,00,000**

1st installment BDT 3,00,000 during admission and the rest amount in 4 equal installments of BDT 1,50,000 in every six months.

•For SAARC students

Total course fee: **USD 15,000**

1st installment USD 5,000 during admission and the rest amount in 2 equal installments of USD 5,000 in every ten months.

•For International students

Total course fee: **USD 18,000**

1st installment USD 6,000 during admission and the rest amount in 2 equal installments of USD 6,000 in every ten months.
